Simon Horn's American Colonial bed

This is an unusual interpretation of a four-poster bed, retaining the posts, but not the canopy or curtains, which were considered unnecessary when the traditional English four-poster made its way across the Atlantic. The elegantly turned posts can be of uniform height, or those at the foot of the bed lower.
