1 ADDRESS BOOK: GARDEN CHAIRS

Similar to the ones in Casa Mosaica, this chair, from **The Heveningham Collection** (01489-89348; www.heveningham.co.uk) comes in dark green, gun metal, black or white. It measures 99 x 43 x 54cm and costs £665.

2 SOURCE: TERRACOTTA POTS

Pots and Pithoi (01342-714793; www.potsandpithoi.com) has a fantastic range of terracotta pots in every size and shape imaginable. They are all made in Crete but would look perfectly at home in an Andalusian garden, or in this country – they are guaranteed frost-proof. Pictured is 'Zaccharias', 40 x 33cm, £67.
